It's really important that we have residents from all areas of the City as census workers. This will help inform our residents of the importance of accurately completing and returning the 2010 Census form. You will play an integral part of ensuring that we have an accurate count. An accurate count equates to \$\$\$ for the City.

The money we receive from Federal, State, and County funding is based on population counts. Census 2010 statistics affect funding levels for 10 years.

Here is some information we want to share with you and also ways you can help:

- Contact the Census Bureau and become a census worker in Lighthouse Point.
- Census forms will be arriving in mid-March 2010. Fill out the form when you receive it and mail it back by April 1<sup>st</sup>. It's really important to everyone in Lighthouse Point that we are all counted.
- An accurate census count will help to keep taxes lower since we will be receiving more funding based on an increase in our population count.
- Pass the message on to your friends and neighbors that it's imperative that census forms need to be completed and returned. This will provide us with an accurate population count in order to receive funding for stormwater repairs, gas tax proceeds, senior program funding, bridge and road repairs, and various grant programs.
- When you discuss Census 2010 with others tell them that the information is confidential for 72 years and not tied to or available to the IRS, property appraiser, immigration, or any government agency. Tell them that everyone living or vacationing in the household on April 1<sup>st</sup>, whether or not they are related, needs to be included on the census form.
