



RECYCLING

The **Recycling Program** in Lighthouse Point is a two part program and easy as 1, 2, 3. All residents shall participate in the City's Recycling program. Two **GREEN** bins are all you need to recycle and they are provided free of charge. The following list outlines what is acceptable in the two bins. Items for Recycling are collected once a week. Place containers at curbside on the designated day. [See Recycling Schedule for your particular home!](#)



In one **GREEN** bin place the following:

- Plastic Bottles, marked with 1, 2, or 3 on the bottom
- Aluminum Steel/Tin Cans (i.e. soda, soup, vegetable, fruit, etc)
- Glass Bottles and Jars, all colors
- Drink boxes and Milk Cartons



In the other **GREEN** bin place the following:

- Newspapers
- Brown Grocery Bags
- Phone Books
- Corrugated Cardboard, be sure to break down (up to 3'x 3')
- All Mixed Paper
 - Catalogs and magazines
 - Old manila file folders
 - Pizza Boxes, be sure to remove any food and the wax paper
 - Paperboard boxes such as, cereal boxes, shoe and tissue boxes
 - Junk Mail, Envelopes (without self adhesive labels)
 - Books (both hard and paperback)
